American NGO to plant one million fruit trees in Morocco

The American High Atlas Foundation is raising money (USD 1 million) to plant one million fruit trees in Moroccan rural areas.

Created in 2000 by former Peace Corps members, the Foundation aspires to plant some 3 million fruit trees over the three coming years.

The association, which supports revenue-generating activities, also contributes in water supply and irrigation infrastructure building in Morocco.

The foundation is a non-profit association that works with the Moroccan government and NGOs to achieve community development projects.
